The position will functionally report to the Chief Compliance Officer.

An effective Data Privacy Management System is of greatest importance in order to protect personal data within a corporate environment and to ensure it is lawfully processed by the organization. With the EU General Data Protection Regulation having come into force in May 2018, the risk for non-compliance in the area of data protection has increased significantly.

In order to strengthen data protection governance within Fujifilm group companies in Europe, the new position of the European Data Privacy Manager will be established as soon as possible, but no later than 1st April 2019.

The European Data Privacy Manager will assume an essential role in managing the data privacy activities at European Headquarter level and advise, facilitate, coordinate and share know-how with local group companies within Europe.

Your tasks and responsibilities include:

- Further development of our European Data Privacy organisation, policies, guidelines as well as implementation and maintenance thereof.
- Enhancement and maintenance of our European data privacy inventory (GDPR article 30) systems, including management of relevant IT applications.
- Management and coordination of personal data breach notification system for Fujifilm group companies in Europe.
- Management of data subject rights requests for European headquarter group entities.
- Management of the European Data Privacy Organisation.
- Monitoring compliance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), other applicable data protection provisions, as well as internal policies and guidelines.
- Design and execution of data privacy training and workshops.
- Management of European Data Privacy organisation budget responsibilities including IT, legal advice and training
- Provision of data privacy management for European headquarter group entities.

- Assuming the role as a data protection officer for FEG and optionally for the other Fujifilm group companies based in Germany.

What we expect from you:

- Relevant university degree e.g. in law, economics, computer science and/or similar relevant additional education.
- Minimum of 10 years working experience of which 3 years must have been performed in the area of data protection compliance.
- Solid expertise in international data protection and privacy laws such as the GDPR.
- Project management experience.
- Excellent presentation and communication skills in English and German both oral and in writing, other languages skills are a plus.
- Outstanding cross-functional collaboration skills
- Cross-cultural, commercial and organizational awareness.
- Excellent knowledge of IT applications, Google applications and data base applications.
